Advice Letter No. 216-W

February 16, 2016

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Liberty Utilities (Apple Valley Ranchos Water) Corp. (U 346 W) ("Liberty Apple Valley") hereby transmits the following revised tariff sheets applicable to water service in its service territory:

The purpose of this filing is to recover the difference between the interim rates established by Advice Letter 194-W, effective January 1, 2015 and Advice Letter 199-W-A, effective June 1, 2015 and the final rates established by Advice Letter 204-W, effective November 24, 2015 in compliance with Decision 15-11-030.

Background and Discussion

These tariffs are submitted as authorized by Decision 15-11-030, Ordering Paragraph No. 4:

Within sixty days of the adoption of this decision, Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company (AVR) is authorized to file a Tier 2 Advice Letter to recover the difference between the interim rates and final rates from its customers in all districts. The difference between the interim and final rates based on the revenue requirement adopted here, shall be recovered over the balance of the rate case cycle.

The new rates authorized by Decision 15-11-030 became effective on November 23, 2015. Liberty Apple Valley bills on a bi-monthly basis, and as a result, all bills including some at the interim rate, were not issued until January 23, 2016. Liberty Apple Valley did

not have the necessary billing information until 60 days after the effective date of the rate change; and furthermore needed to calculate the final balance in the Interim Rates Memorandum Account, and the surcharge to amortize the balance. Accordingly, Liberty Apple Valley requested a 4-week extension until February 15, 2016 to comply with Ordering Paragraph No. 4 of Decision 15-11-030. On January 19, 2016, the Executive Director of the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") granted Liberty Apple Valley's request.

Liberty Apple Valley has determined the difference between the rates authorized by Decision 15-11-030 and the interim rates authorized by the Commission for the period January 1, 2015 through November 24, 2015. The total revenue shortfall is calculated using recorded customer and usage consumption for that period. For the domestic system, the total calculated revenue shortfall is \$2,919,183. With interest through January 31, 2016 the total under-collected balance is \$2,923,163. The increase in revenues would generate an increase in uncollectible and franchise expense of \$42,971. The total revenue to be recovered is \$2,966,134 or approximately 12.80% of Liberty Apple Valley's 2016 adopted revenue requirements. For the irrigation system, the total revenue calculated was \$6,883. With interest through January 31, 2016 the total shortfall is \$6,894. The increase in revenues would generate an increase of \$101 in uncollectible and franchise expense. The total revenue to be recovered is \$6,995 or approximately 3.18% of the irrigation system's 2016 adopted revenue requirements.

Liberty Apple Valley is requesting to recover the shortfall of \$2,973,129 until the balance is fully amortized as stated in Ordering Paragraph No. 4. Liberty Apple Valley is proposing a 21-month surcharge of \$0.458 per Ccf for domestic service for Schedule No. 1, Residential General Metered Service, and Schedule No. 3, Non-Residential General Metered Service, \$0.009 per Ccf for Schedule No. 2, Gravity Irrigation Service, and \$9.78 per month for Schedule No. 4, Non-Metered Fire Service.

The Commission Staff has been provided with workpapers showing the derivation of the surcharges and interest.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to D.15-11-030, this advice letter is submitted with Tier 2 Designation.

Effective Date

Pursuant to General Rule 7.3.4 of General Order 96-B, Liberty Apple Valley requests this filing become effective on March 17, 2016.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on February 16, 2016 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Customer notification of this increase was previously accomplished in A.11-01-001 as required by Rule No. 3.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Additional public notice of this filing is not required.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow Staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
