### **Yes on V Campaign Announces Campaign Committee**

August 30, 2016—Apple Valley, CA—The Apple Valley Citizens Right to Vote on Debt Campaign announced today the formation of volunteer campaign committee, lead by two long-time leaders in the community. Pat Hanson, who along with her late husband Chuck were the original ballot measure proponents, joins former Apple Valley Town Councilman Peter Allan as Co-Chairs of the Committee.

“Measure V is simple, clear and respects Apple Valley voters. It guarantees our right to vote on public debt exceeding \$10 million,” said Mrs. Hanson. “My late husband Chuck and I felt very strongly about our rights and the need to reel in runaway spending by the Town Council. They refused to give us a voice. That’s why we committed ourselves to this measure.”
